President's Report

The annexed statement shows receipts and disbursements for the year 1922. Following the established policy, no expenditures have been authorized beyond what could be paid out of the current year's taxes, and, hence, at this time the Village is free from debt and will have the current year's income available for current expenses.

It has been voted to build a permanent concrete bridge over the culvert adjoining the White Rock Cottage, and this will perhaps be completed during the present year.

No additional sewer lines have been installed, although some are badly needed. This work should, in my opinion, be pushed as rapidly as funds are available for the purpose. I therefore recommend that the voters authorize a Village Corporation tax levy for the year 1924 in the amount of \$500.00.
