President's Report

As will be noted from the Treasurer's report, the Village finances are in sound condition.

During the current season, the streets and parks have not been kept up to quite the usual standard. This is due to the inability of the Road Commissioner to secure labor. With the completion of the State road to Belfast, this defect will doubtless disappear.

The fire hazard in the Campground is serious. Much has been done to remedy dangerous conditions during the past few years. By direction of the Building Inspector, the risks incident to defective chimneys have been greatly reduced. The incoming Village officers should direct that the outlets of all chimneys should be of sufficient height above surrounding buildings to protect the roofs from flying sparks.

The culverts and crossings at White Rock Cottage and Kelley's Cove are in bad condition. These should be replaced with permanent structures with ornamental rails.

Additional sewer construction has been delayed for lack of funds. This work, however, should be resumed whenever financial conditions warrant.

I note with profound regret the death of Mr. Eugene R. Conner, for a number of years one of the Overseers of this Village.
