President's Report

The chief permanent improvements since the last report are somewhat extensive electric wiring of the Village Hall, which was presented by Mr. B. S. Ferguson, and the erection of a permanent band-stand in one of the parks. Appropriation has been made for the erection of a substantial railing on the bridge over the watercourse near the "White Rock" Cottage.

The Village finances are in good order,—all permanent improvements and expenses for the current year having been paid out of cash on hand and cash items as shown by the Treasurer's report.

Fire extinguishers of an efficient type have been placed, and are expected to be maintained at several points in the thickly-settled districts. Each householder should keep informed of the several locations and the manner of operation.

Your president, after serving thirteen successive terms, will not offer himself for election for the next ensuing year.
